Pre-game Schedule

GUIDELINES:

1. Respect the facility (clean up all trash and equipment)
2. Teams must warm-up/practice in designated areas only
3. No infield/outfield is permitted on the game fields at any location
4. Each team must make sure that the starting pitcher is ready by game time
5. Teams that do not follow these guidelines can be banned from practice areas
6. See a Ripken Baseball Tournament Official if any problems/conflicts arise

RIPKEN YOUTH ACADEMY

Each team will be allowed to use one cage (at the academy only) for 30 minutes. When teams are not in the cages, they will be allowed on either the Synthetic Turf Field or Rookie Field for warm-up depending upon the location of their game. Teams warming up to play on one of the 4 replica fields (Cal Sr. Yard, Fenway, Memorial, and Wrigley) will be allowed on the Synthetic Turf Field. Teams warming up to play on Single A, Double A, or Triple A will be allowed on Rookie Field for warm-up. **Teams must warm-up in the designated areas only in order to protect the safety of other players, coaches, spectators, and staff.**

1 hour 15 min. before game time

40 minutes before game time

10 minutes before game time

Visiting teams each get one cage

Home teams each get one cage

Both teams report to game field prepared to play

RIPKEN STADIUM

Teams that are warming up to play in Ripken Stadium are allowed to use the RF cages only. There are two cages there so teams will have to share the space.

-All teams must report to the game field at least **10min. before game time**

-No Infield/Outfield is permitted before the game at Ripken Stadium

-Teams may throw in the outfield or run along the warning track right before the game

-Pitchers are to warm-up along the warning track only

HCC – HARFORD COMMUNITY COLLEGE, ABERDEEN HIGH SCHOOL & JOHN

CARROLL SCHOOL

There is limited practice area at these facilities. Each team will be on their own to warm-up in an open area that is safe for everyone to throw and run. Please share the space, there may be other teams warming up at the same time.

-All teams must report to the game field at least **10 min. before game time**

-No Infield/Outfield is permitted on the game fields

-Teams may throw in the outfield or run along the warning track right before the game

-Pitchers are to warm-up along the warning track only

STANCILL PARK

There is one batting cage behind the 3rd base dugout that teams are allowed to use.

All other fields at this complex are off-limits – Do not go on them for any reason!

-All teams must report to the game field at least **10 min. before game time**

-No Infield/Outfield is permitted on the game field

-Teams may throw in the outfield or run along the warning track right before the game

-Pitchers are to warm-up along the warning track only
